
Grants are designed to cover the operating expenses associated with a research study or project. Here are the most common types of grants given by CIHR.



Operating Grants

fund researchers working in **specific priority** areas identified by CIHR.


Training Grants

support and develop the **next generation** of health researchers.



Project Grants

support research projects proposed and conducted by researchers in any area of the health sciences.




Catalyst Grants

provide one year of funding, often for new, experimental areas of investigation before researchers apply for larger grants.

Team Grants

support multidisciplinary research teams.





Planning and Dissemination Grants

support **planning** or **partnership** development activities that focus on communicating research evidence.

Chairs

support **professors** or **research fellows** recognized for the **excellence** and **impact** of their research.
